ORLANDO, Fla. The program now includes a total of more than 180 properties available for exchange or under development in approximately 35 countries.

Joining the program in the Caribbean and Central and South America were Tradewinds Cruise Clubs in Guadeloupe and St. Martin, La Reunion Golf Resort & Residences in Guatemala, Quintas Private Residences in Brazil and Palazzo Park in Manuel Antonio, Costa Rica.

Additions to *The Registry Collection* program in Asia and the Pacific included Six Senses Hideaway Ninh Van Bay in Vietnam, and delMango Villa Estate Seminyak Gardens in Indonesia. *The Registry Collection* program also added The Residences at Baglioni Marrakech in Morocco and The Village at Machrihanish Dunes in Scotland.
